

Regulations Governing the Fishing Lake at the Château of Javarzay 2021

SEASON OPENS : for holders of annual cards only, Saturday 27th February 2021 at 8.00 a.m.
and for all other anglers, Sunday 28th February 2021 at 8.00 a.m.

HOURS of OPENING : - from 27th February to 16th May 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m.
- from 17th May to 12th September 7.00 a.m. to 11.00 p.m.
- from 13th September to close of season 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m.

Entering the fishin area more than one hour prior to opening, (i.e. 7.00 a.m. for 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 a.m. for 7.00 a.m.) is strictly prohibited. Any action which might be considered to be fishing is prohibited before the official opening time.

No fishing on Tuesdays, except Bank Holidays and during June, July and August

SEASON CLOSES

Monday 29th November 2021 at 8.00 p.m. for holders of day cards

Sunday 12th December 2021 at 8.00 p.m. for holders of annual cards

PRICES :

Annual card	68 €	Day card	8 €
Annual card, under 16s	34 €	Day card, under 16s	4 €

(under 16s are those born after 1st January 2006)

Children under 6 (born after 1st January 2016) free but only with a line without reel.

Annual cards must bear the photograph of the holder.

RULES TO BE OBSERVED WHEN FISHING :

- **ONLY ONE ROD** to be used on Saturdays and the day after the release of fish during the period when the lake is being stocked with young fish, that is from the opening to 27th May and from 16th September to the closure. On all other days, a **maximum** of two rods per angler is allowed. **These must be supervised by their owners. Under no circumstances may an angler leave the lake and at the same time leave his rods in action.**
- Reserving places for other anglers is prohibited.
- One single hook per line.
- Feeder Fishing is allowed, in July and August.
- Spoons and all other lures are prohibited until 31st October. From 1st of November these may be used until the end of the season.
- **Carp fishers must have the following equipment:** unhooking mat, suitable landing net, weigh sling and appropriate disinfectant. Carp fishers must use barbless hooks.
- **All baiting is prohibited**
- **The number of catches per fishing day is limited to :**
 - 6 for salmonidae (trout or speckled trout), of which 3 weighing more than 1 kilo
 - 2 for pike-perch more than 50cms in length (others must be returned to the water)
 - 2 for carp (less than 5 kilos) and tench. -Carp of more than 5 kilos and grass carp must be returned to the water.
- **Sturgeons must be killed** on site before being removed;
- 2 drop nets of crayfish per angler are allowed. The crayfish caught **must be killed** on site.
- No catches are to be transferred to vehicles during the fishing day.
- Fishing is **prohibited** on Sunday 25th April (Lake reserved by a Chef-Boutonne Association), on Wednesday 14th July (Preparation of Fire Work Display). In addition **the commune of Chef-Boutonne reserves the right to close the lake** to satisfy any request for a particular event.
- Fishing is **prohibited** because of competitions:

- ✓ Saturdays 27th March, 24th April and 23th October for 3 trout fishing competitions
- ✓ The weekends of 21st to 24th May, 2th to 04th July and 3th to 5th September for 3 carp competitions.

- The pontoon at the rue de Judée access point **is for the use of disabled persons only**.
- The moving of tables and the lighting of fires by the lake are both **prohibited**.
- The **use of mopeds and bicycles is strictly prohibited** on the path around the lake which is reserved for anglers and walkers. On this path **and everywhere else on the site** all motorised vehicles are strictly prohibited and **dogs must be on a leash**.

FISH STOCKING SEASON 2021 :

- Anglers will be notified of releases by items in the press and notices around the lake. On the days when fish are to be released fishing is prohibited after 6.00 p.m. up till June and after 5.30 p.m. from September.
- Should the temperature of the water be too high, the commune of Chef Boutonne reserves the right to postpone certain releases. Information will be available in the newspaper and from posters around the lake.
- **Any non-authorized release of fish is prohibited.**

CAR PARKS :

Three car parks are available for anglers :

- Rue de Judée car park
- Château de Javarzay car park

TOILETS :

Automated toilets are available near the pontoon for the disabled by the rue de Judée, to the north of the site.

PENALTIES :

The Gendarmerie and named members of the Association P.E.C.H, holders of a card of authorisation (with photo) from the mairie, will carry out checks at the lake to ensure the correct observation of these rules.

All anglers are obliged to be aware of these regulations and any failure to observe them may be penalised by the cancellation or temporary suspension of the fishing card or by a fine.
